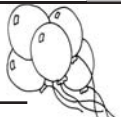
The menu is still being put together, so the cost is not yet available, TBD but should be in the \$12-\$13 dollar range.

June, we have some Third Degree's up coming, and a OSI on the 24th, the Table Lodge and Honored Ladies Lunch.

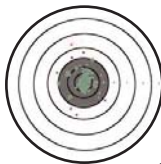
This is a good time to remind all of our brethren to come on down to Lodge and share the fellowship with us.

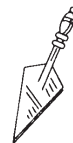
